1. Thank you for your email of 24 September 2021 in which you requested information from UK Anti-Doping ('UKAD') under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').
2. Specifically, your request was as follows:
 - *How many times has your organisation suffered a ransomware attack?*
 - *Please detail the number of successful and unsuccessful attacks*
 - *In the case of successful attacks, how much downtime did each cause?*
 - *Did you pay the ransom?*
 - *How much did the ransom cost?*

Response

3. In response to your request, UKAD can confirm that it has never suffered a successful ransomware attack. Records of unsuccessful attacks are not kept and spam logs are only retained for 90 days.

Conclusion

4. If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review.
