Testing Programme Summary

The period under review in this report is 1 January – 31 March 2016. During this time, the domestic and international Anti-Doping Testing Programme carried out 2044 tests.

Of the 2044 Tests in Quarter 4, 313 (15.31%) were attempted under the jurisdiction of an International Federation.
