Thank you for your email of 6 March 2020 in which you requested information from UK Anti-Doping ('UKAD') under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

Specifically, your request was as follows:

 Excluding EPC ratings, does your organisation measure carbon emissions due to energy use in relation to your built assets? Yes / No / Partially / Don't know

Response: UKAD does not have any built assets therefore this question is not applicable to UKAD. Fleetbank House is not our built asset and the landlord is responsible for this measurement.

2. What was the annual carbon footprint (in CO2) of your organisation's HQ building in 2018?

Response: This information is not known because only the landlord has the information which might enable this to be measured. This information is not shared with UKAD.

3. Does your organisation have a carbon emissions reduction plan in place, for energy use related to your built assets? Yes / No / Don't know

Response: This question is not applicable to UKAD as UKAD is not responsible for the energy use in the building and cannot measure its own use.

4. With the UK Government having signed legislation to commit the UK to a legally binding target of net zero carbon emissions by 2050, is your





organisation already planning towards 'net zero carbon' operation by 2050? Yes / Partially / No / Don't know

Response: UKAD does not have a plan in place or in development.
