Dear

 Thank you for your email of 23 February 2022 in which you requested information from UK Anti-Doping ('UKAD') under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'). Specifically your request was as follows:

a. How many athletes have been cleared of ADRV's (Anti-Doping Rule Violation has not been committed) by the NADP in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023 to present. Please provide a break down by year.

b. Please can UKAD provide a break of which sport each athlete above competed in.

c. Please can UKAD list which ADRV each athlete was initially charged with. In the cases which involved a positive drug test/AAF (presence of a prohibited substance) please can UKAD list the substance.

d. Please can UKAD also clarify whether these athletes were cleared of an ADRV in a first instance decision or on appeal.

3. UKAD confirms that it holds material relevant to your request. Accordingly, it has completed a table as follows:

4. With regards to the table above, please note the following:

a. The 'Year' column indicates the year the decision was handed down by an independent tribunal of the National Anti-Doping Panel ('NADP'); and

b. The table reflects decisions where the NADP has concluded that the Anti-Doping Rule Violation(s) ('ADRVs') charged were not proven to the 'comfortable satisfaction' standard of the hearing panel. This standard of proof is greater than a mere balance of probability but less than proof beyond a reasonable doubt, as set out in Article 8.4.1 of the UK Anti-Doping Rules<sup>1</sup>.
