 Thank you for your email of 24 June 2024 in which you requested information from UK Anti-Doping ('UKAD') under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').
 The specific terms of your request are set out below:

Request 1

As per UKAD's regulations it states the protocols for how UKAD manages the Results Management process involving Adverse Passport Findings in Athlete Biological Passport (ABP) cases:

7.5.1 Where an Atypical Passport Finding or other ABP-related case is referred to a single expert from the Expert Panel in accordance with Article 5.5.5, and the opinion of the single expert is 'likely doping', the file will be referred to a group of three experts from the Expert Panel (composed of the single expert appointed in the initial review and two further experts chosen by the APMU from the Expert Panel) for consideration in accordance with ISRM Annex C.

7.5.2 Where all of the three experts from the Expert Panel, having reviewed the ABP Documentation Package, render a joint opinion of 'likely doping' (an "Adverse Passport Finding"), UKAD shall send the Athlete a Notice in accordance with Article 7.8.

Where a Notice is issued to an Athlete based on an Adverse Analytical Finding or <u>Adverse Passport Finding</u> for a Prohibited Substance that is not a Specified Substance or for Use of a Prohibited Method that is not a Specified Method, then (subject only to Article 7.10.3) <u>a Provisional Suspension will come into effect automatically on the date specified by UKAD in the Notice.</u>
