 Thank you for your email of 23 April 2024 in which you requested information from UK Anti-Doping ('UKAD') under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'). Specifically, your request was as follows:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, I am writing to request the contact details of the person or department responsible for managing your organisation's energy contracts and procurement.

We are currently conducting a nationwide review into the mismanagement of energy billing across the sector. Our findings show that around 42% of businesses are being incorrectly charged — including unnecessary Climate Change Levy (CCL) charges and overpaid VAT — also looking at supporting in cost reduction solutions and guidance in to procurement strategies

To support this analysis and determine whether any corrections or refunds may be applicable along with the best stratagies [sic], I would also be grateful if you could provide a copy of a recent electricity and gas bill) for review.

Response

- UKAD does not hold the information sought in your request.
- Please note that UKAD leases its office spaces in Loughborough and Stratford.
 UKAD is invoiced by its respective landlords for its use of the office spaces it leases. UKAD has no direct contact with energy suppliers.
